Friendly Reminders

- If you are watching your child's class through the window and notice that your child is paying more attention to you than their teacher, this can be distracting to the class. Please step away from the window so our teachers can have your child's full attention.
- Parents of our younger dancers: please make sure your child uses the bathroom before class begins. Once one dancer leaves for the bathroom, it often starts a chain reaction where several others feel the need to go as well, which disrupts class time.
- **Tuition** is due by the **15th of each month** and remains the same every month. Payments received after the 15th will incur a **\$15 late fee**. Returned checks will result in a **\$25 fee**.
- Tuition is non-refundable.
- The field behind the North Brookfield Studio **does not belong to KADS**. Please do not allow children to play on the grass in the back.
- Be sure to **pick up your children on time** after class.
- If your child is sick, please **keep them home** until they are feeling better.
- A **\$25 deposit per class** for recital costumes is due by **November 15**.
