**Dress Rehearsal**

All dancers are required to be at Dress Rehearsal, in costume, tights and hair done. If you have not already looked at the costume pictures in the studio, please do! On each costume picture, tights, shoes and hair style is listed. Dancers will come to dress rehearsal in costume, and will be seated in the auditorium. The finale will be rehearsed first, all dancers will participate in the finale. Once we rehearse the finale, all dancers will be seated back in the auditorium with their class. We will start with the youngest dancers first at dress rehearsal. Once your dancer is finished practicing on stage, you are free to take them home. Only 1 parent per dancer is allowed at dress rehearsal, so siblings or other family members allowed.

**Recital Day**

On recital day, dancers should arrive 30 minutes before the start of the show, and head straight to the dressing room. I am looking for some parent volunteers to supervise the dressing rooms. Any parents that volunteer will receive \$50 off their September tuition for the new season. Any parents that volunteer must stay in the dressing room the entire show. There will be a sign up sheet on the counter at the studio for volunteers. I am looking for 3-4 volunteers for the 10:00 & 2:00 shows. Dancers will stay in the dressing room until it is their time to perform. They will be brought to the stage to perform and then right back to the dressing room. If you would like your dancer to watch the show, a ticket must be purchased for them. Anyone seated in the auditorium must have a ticket. If you purchase a ticket for your child, please make sure they are in the dressing room at least 5 numbers before they perform. All dancers will be brought backstage again for the finale. Once the finale is over, we keep the dancers seated on the stage and parents will come to the stage to take their dancer home.

**REMINDERS:**

- We are very excited to have our recital back on a stage!! As we all know, rules can change FAST! As of right now, masks are NOT required but suggested for unvaccinated people.
- Recital tickets will go on sale June 1. More information will be sent home about ticket sales soon.
- June tuition must be paid by JUNE 7. All accounts must be up to date by June.
- Recital t-shirts will be available to purchase ONLINE ONLY. We will not have any available to purchase at the shows. More information will be sent home soon.
- Don't forget to bring in a recital program business ad, or purchase an ad for your dancer, or a recital message for your dancer in our recital program. That information was sent home last week.
- Most costumes are in!! Ordering recital costumes has been a nightmare this year for many reasons, supply chain issues, many come from China, and a couple major costume companies permanently closed at the beginning of the pandemic. The remaining companies are working around the clock to get all costumes out to dance studios all over the country. Please be patient if your child's costume is not in yet.

- Summer dance registration is open. Don't forget to sign up for our summer classes. There is no weekly commitment for summer dance, you can sign up for 1 or as many classes as you'd like.
